## MYAAMIA TRADITIONAL KNOWLEDGE GRANT PROGRAM

### **Call for Proposal 2013:**

The Myaamia Traditional Knowledge Grant Program supports the dissemination of Myaamia language, cultural knowledge, and practices among the various Myaamia tribal communities. A variety of projects that are broad in scope and content can be supported by this program. Some examples include workshops, research projects, community presentations or demonstrations, publications, and any public display or dissemination of Myaamia language and cultural knowledge. For the purposes of this grant, *Myaamia Traditional Knowledge* is defined as a community recognized practice that existed during or before the beginning of the 20th century. Reclamation efforts of currently dormant cultural practices are acceptable but must be supported by community cultural leaders with letters of support as part of the application.

Appropriate expenses include travel, equipment, consultant fees (especially for elders), materials, etc. We do not fund overhead costs. If you have questions regarding allowable expenses, please contact the foundation's executive director. These grants are typically 1-2 year projects, although extensions are possible, and should range between \$2,000 and \$10,000.

### **Eligibility:**

Must be enrolled members of the Miami Tribe of Oklahoma or the Miami Nation of Indiana. Proof of enrollment is required.

### **Deadline:**

Submit all applications in PDF format by midnight June 1, 2013.

### **How to Apply:**

Please use the Grant Application and Outline Form to prepare your proposal. Feel free to expand on the application as needed for your individual project or program. When finished, email the application in PDF format to **ExecutiveDirector@myaamiafoundation.org**. A confirmation email will be sent to you after the application is received and reviewed for completeness. Incomplete applications will be returned with comments.
